## ZIMTA DECLARATION STATEMENT

## **INDUSTRIAL ACTION: DISPUTE ON SALARY AWARDS 2019**

## We the **ZIMBABWE TEACHER'S ASSOCIATION;**

**HAVING** afforded dialogue a chance to resolve the grievances that were raised by our members *inter alia* erosion of purchasing power of their salaries and the rise of prices of basic commodities and services;

**ALARMED** by the fact that the government is offering meagre salary adjustment;

**FURTHER CONCERNED** that the purported cushioning allowance offered allegedly from the President is far from addressing the economic challenges facing our general membership;

**HAVING** declared incapacitation on the part of our membership since the opening of schools on the 8<sup>th</sup> January 2019;

**NOTING** that the dispute is one of interest and has since escalated without any final resolution;

**AND FURTHER** after getting call and support from over eighty percent (80%) of our membership;

**FURTHER HAVING**, through our umbrella body the Apex Council, given sufficient legal notice to embark on collective job action on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2019 which notice lapsed on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019;

**NOW THEREFORE** it is declared that our members shall exercise their right in terms of **section 65 (3) of the Constitution of Zimbabwe Amendment (No.20) Act, 2013** by embarking on collective job action (strike) commencing on 05<sup>th</sup> February 2019.
